### Where does the money from “Shark For a Day” Fantasy Camp go?

### What is the cost of the 2009 event?

This cost of this year’s “Shark For a Day” Fantasy Camp is \$1,800.

### What if I sign up, but decide to drop out?

Refunds from fully paid enrollment will only be given as follows:

### What is included in the cost?

- an authentic, personalized Sharks jersey
- a practice jersey
- game and practice socks
- breakfast, lunch, dinner
- one (1) ticket to watch the Sharks game from the Penthouse Plaza
- custom, team-issued apparel (i.e. jackets, shirts, bags, etc...)
- a framed photo commemorating the event
- morning skate
- Fantasy Game with alumni on HP Pavilion ice

### What hockey gear do I need to bring?

You will need to bring all of your hockey gear including:

- skates
- shin guards
- jock or pelvic protector

- hockey pants
- shoulder pads
- elbow pads
- helmet (face cage/visor optional, but recommended)
- stick
- gloves
- skate guards

What is the schedule of the day (tentative)?

- 7 a.m. Participants arrive and change
- 8 – 9 a.m. Morning skate
- 10 – 11:30 a.m. Sharks and Minnesota Wild morning skate (optional)
- 11:45 – 12:45 p.m. Lunch with broadcasters and alumni
- 1:15 – 3:15 p.m. Fantasy Game
- 4:30 – 6:30 p.m. Reception
- 7:30 p.m. Sharks vs. Minnesota Wild from the Penthouse Plaza

Can I use this as a charity tax write-off?

The Sharks can provide you with a letter stating the price of participation and the goods and services received. After that, it is up to you and your tax advisor whether or not this is eligible for a tax deduction.

Are guests allowed to attend?

Guests are welcome to attend the Fantasy Game. A few weeks before the event, we will ask each participant for a list of names to put on the guest list. During the game, guests can video tape or take photographs from the stands. Guests will not be permitted at any other portion of the event.

Can I have an extra ticket to the Penthouse Plaza?

We will determine if any extra tickets are available a few weeks prior to the event.

Who are the alumni scheduled to attend?

We will release information on the participating 2009 alumni in the coming months. Last year, Jeff Friesen, Igor Larionov, Jamie Baker, Al Iafrate, David Maley and Bryan Marchment all participated in the event.

What is the game format?

The game is a 60-minute running clock with short breaks (less than 5 minutes) between periods. There will be no checking allowed in the contest.
